Position Outline: The Supervised Access Worker oversees and facilitates visits between children in care and their birth parents or grandparents. Duties include, meeting the needs of the children by ensuring a positive and safe experience for the parents and child. Creating a secure visit environment for the child and intervening if necessary. All SAW's will produce written reports of their observations of visits and submitted daily.

Responsibilities:

- Transport children between caregivers.
- Ensure children are supervised while in your care.
- Create written reports after each visit, submitted as required.

Qualifications:

- Certificate in any field related to social services, with skills in conflict resolution, child protection, early childhood development is preferred.
- Minimum of 2 years' experience working with children and families.
